Tennis Rules

1. Eligibilty to Join

- 1. Any Full member of the Carlton Club.
- 2. Any partner of a Full member of the Carlton Club.
- 3. Any Cadet member of the Carlton Club may join by subscription (14-17years inclusive).

1. 2. Use of the Courts

- 1. Full Tennis Section members and Cadet members may play at any time.
- 2. Full Tennis Section members may introduce guests at any time upon payment of the required fee, at present £3.00. This fee to be put into the appropriate tin and the Guest Book signed.
- 3. When any Tennis Section member is waiting to play due to the courts being full any game being played shall finish after seven (7) games.
- 4. When members are waiting both courts must play doubles.
- 5. Cadet members are not allowed to bring guests, as per Club Rule 23 (3).
- 6. League matches will take precedence in the use of the courts.

3. Membership Fees

Membership fees shall be determined by the Carlton Club Committee – notification being made

in the usual manner annually as with all Club members.

1. **4. Dress Code**

- 1. Only rubber soled shoes to be worn on the courts.
- 2. Appropriate clothing, including the wearing of shirts, must be worn at all times as per Rule 27, para.2.

1. **5. Guests**

- 1. The Tennis Section member introducing a guest shall be responsible for that person whilst they are on Club premises.
- 2. The Tennis Captain is responsible for passing any monies, from Guest fees, to the Treasurer monthly.

1. **6.** Tennis Balls

- 1. Tennis balls are provided by the Carlton Club for use by Tennis Section members and will be ordered and supplied, as necessary, by a nominated member of the Tennis Section..
- 2. The cost will be paid by the Club Treasurer against a receipt.
- 3. Used balls, still fit for purpose, to be stored in the box on court should, where possible, be kept in their sets and containers.
- 4. Tennis balls which are unsuitable for further use shall be disposed of after ermoval from the courts.

1. 7. Security and Access to the Courts

- 1. Tennis Section members will be given a court key, upon joining, after payment of £10.
- 2. This fee is refundable upon return of the key when ceasing membership of the Tennis Section.
- 3. Any replacement key necessary will be charged at £10.
- 4. Access to the Club garden, when the Club is not open, shall be via the side gate. The access code/key shall be given to all Tennis Section members.
- 5. A key to the courts shall be held behind the bar and issued only for the following reasons –
- (i) Persons carrying out work to the courts as authorised by the Carlton Club Committee.
- (ii) Tennis Section members as per the list on the Club noticeboard.
- (iii) Any Club member on payment of £3 guest fee.
 - 1. The last member(s) to use the courts shall ensure that –
- (i) The nets are lowered
- (ii) The tennis balls are stored as at Rule 6 c,
- (iii) The courts are locked,
- (iv) The side gate is closed and secured.
